<p>Over recent years Barham Parish Council has consistently supported applications for small developments within the Parish. This is evidenced by our responses to planning applications 18/02758, 2113/16 and 0191/17. These are small developments of between 10 and 30 properties that are either infill or on land of limited agricultural value. In addition we have supported small infill developments of 1 – 3 properties. This demonstrates that we are not opposed to all housing growth in our village.</p> <p>To continue the Councils approach to making use of low value land for development, we would like to propose the use of the land between Pest House Lane, Lower Crescent and the A14 as a possible site for housing or employment land.</p> <p>Barham Parish Council objects to these (Claydon with Part Barham LA001 – LA002 – LA003) developments on the basis of our responses to planning applications 1856/17 and 18/0086. To avoid duplication I refer you to our responses to these applications which, along with residents comments, can be found on your planning portal. We would also like to bring to your attention that there appears to be no relationship in the joint plan to the reality of current planning applications. Application 1856/17 is now proposing approx. 270 houses and not over 300 as proposed by the joint plan. Barham Parish Council would particularly draw your attention to the our commissioned transport consultants reports covering the traffic impacts of these development. Again these are available on your planning portal.</p>
